Many men from rural areas migrate to the cities to gain work to support their families. Others are long distance truck drivers or daily labourers closer to home. CINI's programs prepare people for out-migration, to avoid labour exploitation. Returning men are a common source of HIV infection for women and, in turn, their children during pregnancy.

Asif and his family attended CINI's programs for the first time in March. He went to Delhi as a 20-year old to work in the electrical trade. He has just returned to his village to discover he has TB and HIV. Asif and his family are frightened for his future. CINI is helping them understand the illness, get medication, gain confidence and develop a support base in their community.

Building the skills, confidence and financial security of young adults and adolescents is an increasingly important part of CINI's work. With support from Modus Property, CINI Australia is helping them achieve their hopes for a positive future.
