CINI (Children In Need India) works with children in Kolkata's slums and railways. Two million people pass through the enormous Sealdah railway station every day. On the station platforms, the CINI ChildLine team, many of whom grew up on the station themselves, quickly identify children in danger of being taken by child traffickers.

This worried father pictured above travelled from the country in search of his young son who had disappeared. They were reunited by the ChildLine team who had found him two days earlier.

Last year CINI's ChildLine team rescued over 1000 children who had run away from home, were lost or who had just jumped on the train for an adventure. They arrived from Bhutan, Bangladesh, Nepal and distant parts of India with no idea of the risk. Through collaboration with the railways, police and children services the majority are returned to the safety of their families, unharmed.
